What do you need to do?

comply with Making Tax Digital То legislation, you need to use MTD compatible software to keep digital records and make submissions to HMRC electronically.

When is it happening

Ist Phase - April 2026

Making Tax Digital for Income Tax will apply to self-employed individuals and landlords with turnover (income) over £50,000

2nd Phase - April 2027

Making Tax Digital for Income Tax will apply to self-employed individuals and landlords with turnover (income) over £30,000

3rd Phase - 2029 (awaiting confirmation)

Making Tax Digital for Income Tax will apply to self-employed individuals and landlords with income over £20,000 by the end of this parliament

What Does This Mean for You?

The timeline for MTD depends on your business structure, turnover, and the type of tax you pay. Regardless of your specific start date, preparing early can save you stress and ensure compliance.
